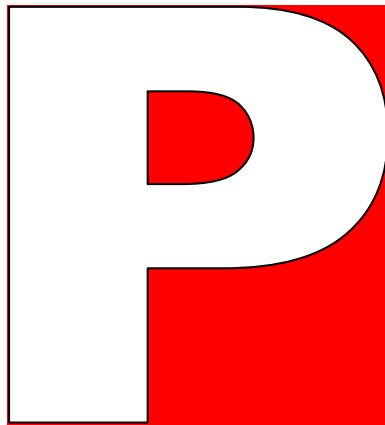


Kidman Trail

A leg-up for those wanting to try longer rides



Hot meals, sleep in a bed!

Horse SA will support you through:

1. **Meeting riders** between 8 am & 9am on Fri 12th and Sat 13th at Echunga Trail Head: to have items taken to Jack's paddock (not floats)
2. **Reserve one horse yard** per booking. Maximum of 8 bookings per shift
3. **Reserve one bed** per booking in Woodcutter's cottage, per shift
4. **Provide a hot meal** at 6.30 pm at Woodcutter's cottage
5. **Set up a campfire** for sharing your trail experiences around
6. **Provide breakfast** at 7 am at Woodcutter's cottage
7. **Provide morning tea** to pack into a saddlebag for those who are riding the next day
8. **Provide Lunch** for those who have booked a "double shift"
9. **Link you up** with other riders who may be looking for someone to ride with
10. **Provide Forest maps** and option to purchase Kidman Trail maps
11. **Invite a guest** to attend the evening meal: to provide insight into long distance riding with horses.

Horse Riders

1. **Start your riding** at Echunga or Willunga Trail head if you have someone to drop you off or Jack's Paddock (Brookman Rd, Meadows) If you have to drive yourself, park at Jack's Paddock, set up a yard, choose your bed and go for a nice ride in the Forest!
2. **Aim to finish** at Jack's Paddock horse yards no later than 4.30 pm to see to your horse, & set up your bed in Woodcutter's Cottage OR if you want to book the nearby www.forestgateg cottages.com.au (includes stabling/spa/four poster bed) we can pick up/drop off so that you can enjoy a campfire and meal with other riders.
3. **Go riding** in the morning again! Yards/beds vacated by 12 noon. Pick up anytime that day.

To provide maximum opportunities, as only 8 overnight horse riders will be taken at one time:

1. **"Shift 1"** Friday June 12th am to Sat 13th. Horse yards and beds to be vacated by 12 noon.
2. **"Shift 2"** Sat. June 13th am to Sun 14th. Horse yards and beds to be vacated by 12 noon.

Please note: Horse SA is not conducting or organizing a trail ride, caring for or transporting horses, only transport of equipment (not driving floats) and meals are supplied. Horse SA has dual booked the Jack's Paddock horse yard facility & Woodcutter's cottage to enable newcomers to long distance riding to experience a day ride and bunk bed-dormitory room style accommodation without having to take a pack horse or back up vehicle. Riders over 18 yrs only.
