## Celebrating our Australian Horse Heritage

An informal poetry competition, with placegetters voted by the patrons of the Stockwell Hotel, Stockwell South Australia.

**First prize \$100 Myer Voucher**

Selected poems will be published in an anthology e-book

### Competition Rules

1. Poems must be themed around our Australian horse heritage.  
**Entries close April 24<sup>th</sup> 2011.** No late entries will be accepted.
2. One class only: **Open**. Poems to be put on the walls of the Hotel on 30 April, 2011. People's choice style of judging. Patrons of the Stockwell Hotel will place voting slips into a box and these will be added up to find the winner/s. One vote per patron. Voting will take place with the lunchtime trade patrons, between 11 am and 2 pm on April 30, 2011.

First prize is a **\$100 Myer voucher**. Additional prizes and merit awards will be given out at the discretion of the organisers.

Prizes will be awarded on the day and publicised on [www.kidmantrail.org.au](http://www.kidmantrail.org.au) and [www.horsesa.asn.au](http://www.horsesa.asn.au) Entrants do not have to be present to receive their prize.

3. Poems must be **original works** and not exceed 50 lines in length. A maximum of three entries will be accepted from each contestant. Entries will be accepted from contestants anywhere in Australia. Each poem entered must be accompanied by a completed separate entry form. Email is the preferred method of receiving entries. Entries may include an original illustration or accompanying photograph photocopied, printed or scanned onto one A4 size paper sheet. Copyright of the illustration or photograph to be held by the author of the poem. A maximum of 2 pages of writing and 1 page of illustration or photograph (3 in total). Entries will not be returned unless specifically requested and self addressed stamped envelope provided.

Entries must be in English on A4 paper, 12 size font, Times New Roman font style, double-spaced with numbered pages (no hand written entries).

The name of the entrant must not appear on any page of the submitted poetry or illustration/photograph.

4. Poems or illustrations deemed to be defamatory, racial, offensive or containing profanities will not be selected for public display or included for voting.
5. Copyright for all poetry entered shall be retained by the individual authors who submitted the work. However, by entering the competition, authors give permission for their work to be included in a published e-book of the poems to be produced for sale for fundraising by Horse SA. The publisher reserves the right to edit all winning entries. This editing will be confined to spelling and punctuation.
6. The brief biography completed on the entry form will accompany the poems selected for publishing.
7. The judge's decision shall be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
